Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Very Best Occasions (159871)
- Cardstock: Shaded Spruce (146981); Daffodil Delight (119683); Basic White (159276)
- Ink: Memento Black (132708)
- Tools & Accessories: Stampin' Blends in Shaded Spruce (154903) and Daffodil Delight (154883); Deckled Rectangles Dies (159173); Festive Pearls (159963); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)
- Designer Paper: Celebrate Everything Designer Series Paper (Hostess Selection 159913)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Shaded Spruce- 5 ½" x 8 ½"
- Cardstock #2: Daffodil Delight- 2 ½" x 4"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White- approx. for rectangle 2 ¼" x 3 ½"
- Cardstock #4: Basic White- 2 ¾" x 5 ¼" for inside liner
- Designer Paper #1: green pieces 1" x 5 ¼" and 1 ½" x 5 ¼": Trees piece 1" x 5 ¼"

Instructions:

- Score card base at 4 ¼" and 1 ¼" on the long side.
- Fold the card base on the 4 ¼" score mark to make your card and then fold the front cover backwards on the 1 ¼" score mark. Then, glue the flap down on the card front. See figure #1.
- Attach the green designer paper (1 ½" x 5 ¼") on the left side of the card front using liquid glue. Attach the other green designer paper (1" x 5 ¼") on the far-right side on the inside of the card.

- Color the tree designer paper strip using the listed Stampin' Blends and attach the strip to the flap on the card front.
- Die-cut a layering Deckled Rectangles in Basic White and Daffodil Delight cardstock.
- Stamp the sentiment using Memento Black ink on the Basic White rectangle. Color the holly leaves with Shaded Spruce Stampin' Blends.
- Attach the Basic White rectangle to the Daffodil Delight rectangle using liquid glue. Then, attach them to the card front flap using Stampin' Dimensionals. Only add Dimensionals to the left half of the sentiment shown in Figure #2.
- Add Basic Cardstock #4 to the inside of the card. Make sure it's more towards the left side so you can't see it when the card is closed.
- Add a few Festive Pearls to the holly near the sentiment to finish your card.
